TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM – Technology (TAP-T) Guidelines 2011-2012

Mission

The Mission of the Monsignor Bonner and Archbishop Prendergast Catholic High School TAP-T program is to expressly help students in need who are interested in integrating technology within the daily classroom environment here at Bonner & Prendie. A student who is selected for technology assistance is one who embodies the values, moral character, and Christian ethics of a Catholic school student.

Program Support:

- Support for the TAP-T will be funded by alumni/nae donations, contributions specifically designated for the TAP-T program and assistance, where applicable, through state funding for educational materials.
- Alumni/nae are directed to send their donation/contribution directly to Fr. Olson, President, with a letter of intent designating the money to the program.
- Monies will be earmarked for the TAP-T account.

Guidelines for Selection:

- Each student must have an opportunity to apply.
- Each student's academic and discipline performance will be reviewed at the time of application and must be in satisfactory standing.
 - If selected:
 - The student must achieve a minimum grade of a 85 in each academic subject area.
 - The student must maintain a discipline record which does not fall below an average of 90 in each quarter.
- All current fees and tuition must be paid in full at the time the application is received.
- Assistance will only be provided to help provide technology accessibility. This does not apply to tuition or school/athletic fees.

Selection Committee:

- A selection committee will be made of three (3) individuals as follows:
 - 1 representative from the school administration
 - 1 representative from the faculty
 - 1 representative from the school's technology committee. (This may be an administrator, Director of Technology, faculty or staff member).
- The selection committee will review all applications for the given sport. Once all applications have been reviewed the committee determine selections, inform the individual of their selection, and determine time to receive the device.
- Those who are selected must read and sign the Computer Use Agreement which may be found on the Bonner Prendie 1:1 Public Portal. This site is linked from both the Bonner and Prendie websites.
